## THROUGH OUR DOORS

It is not unusual for us to get clients referred by friends in the center. It is highly unusual to have sisters and their mother come into the center at the same time. Such was a recent situation that came *through our doors!*

Mom suspected eldest daughter might be 'with child' and came with her to be tested. Eldest daughter would only agree to be tested if Mom was tested, too! Daughter was upset with the number of mom's male friends that had been coming to the house recently. Imagine the surprise in the room when both tests were positive.

To add to the emotion of the afternoon the youngest daughter asked the volunteer-mentor if she, too, could take a test. Immediate silence was followed by intense sobbing from all three women when the youngest daughter's test was also positive.

The good news from all this is that all three have chosen to parent their children and are coming to *Earn While You Learn* classes. Mom is telling us that she is learning things she never knew — even after three children!

The sisters are learning that abstinence until marriage is the best plan for their lives. Mom is finding out that walking the walk is better in teaching daughters than lots of yelling and threatening. Classes with these three are most interesting.

They are all being prayed for by our volunteers and staff. One day soon we hope to have a positive answer from each of them regarding their eternal future in Jesus Christ. Please join us in praying for that, too!
