No one will forget the super delicious fried chicken!




We were treated to music from the talented pianist, Margaret Gray Turner.


MARIA HANIK

She came with her boyfriend. Fear was very evident on her face. "I do not know what to do. Three pregnancy tests have been positive and I'm here to confirm those results. Abortion is my only choice since I would be disowned by my parents and my older sister for being pregnant and not married."

She said she was a believer. The conversation pursued that piece of information with the question how much do you trust the Savior to whom you gave your heart and life? The answer came with a flood of tears -- I trust Him a lot and with all of me! She was asked, "If you trust Him that much with all of you, why do you not trust that he can see you through this pregnancy?"

The boyfriend chimed in with, "you will never be able to go to a family event again or show your face in church because you are pregnant and not married. Are you ready to give all that up for something you can abort and no one will ever be the wiser?" More tears followed.

Then, as if she had cried her last tear and exhausted her last bit of energy, out came a flood of verbiage to the boyfriend and for her ears, too. She told of keeping secrets for her girlfriends who had aborted and watched them struggle with forgiveness for that deliberate act of murder. Forgiveness never came to them because their lives were caught up in people and things that only satisfied for a brief time. She on the other hand had a loving family that even though disappointed in her actions would forgive her because they loved her and followed the example of their Savior, Jesus Christ. To the boyfriend she said in essence, go with me to tell my parents and your parents and own up to your involvement. Then either support my decision to parent this child or get out of my way and my life!
