He and his <u>wife</u> [already this is different] came in the front door with faces that showed obvious concern. The husband had recently managed to move his wife from their country in Asia to the US. He had been here for several years working hard to accomplish this.

The wife needed a test and if it was positive, she needed to find a doctor who spoke her Asian language. The test was positive and the search began to find an obstetrician who spoke her language. It didn't take long to locate such a physician, but the real problem came when the husband learned there was no financial assistance available to his wife since she had only been in the US a couple of months.

Praise God for Christian physicians! When one practice that PROD refers women to on a regular basis learned of this couple's dilemma, they were more than helpful in making arrangements for a payment plan. And the language issue — the couple was willing to use an English speaking obstetrician!

The couple has enrolled in *Earn While You Learn* and are eager to learn about pregnancy and parenting. Pray for us as we present the gospel and challenge them to grow in knowledge of and faith in Jesus Christ.
