If our greatest need had been money, God would have sent us a economist.


If our greatest need had been pleasure, God would have sent us and entertainer.

# THROUGH OUR DOORS

The doorbell rang late one Thursday afternoon. Outside there was a boy, who looked to be about eight years old, and his mother waiting for someone to answer the door. Mom was totally dressed in Muslim attire — head scarf and long dress — such beautiful colors. Through her son, who was the interpreter, she told us that she was pregnant but had not seen a doctor and wanted some help in finding one to see her.

She made an appointment for early the next week. We began trying to figure out how we were going to communicate with her since the son would be in school at that time. The answer came through a pastor in the missions department of FBC Woodstock who contacted a member of the church from a middle eastern country who spoke this mother's language. She and this mom have met each week via phone to get information on pregnancy, parenting, and fetal development. It is thrilling to hear the laughter and surprise in the voice of this mom as these two women grow in friendship! Yes, she was able to find a doctor from the recommendations we gave her.

We are waiting for God to show us the best time to present the gospel to her and her husband, who comes with her each week. The translator says she can tell this mom is gaining knowledge she did not know because of the excitement in her voice at the time of each lesson and how she responds to suggestions given in each lesson. Oh yes, this translator's husband is getting in on the fun too by translating the printed lesson materials and emailing them to us each week before mom comes back.

Please join us in praying for the salvation of this family as she continues to learn new things through *Earn While You Learn* lessons.
